As far as "intellectual property" goes, we get all of our information from AFRA and are under its leadership. I believe Leonard Henderson is the one you should speak to if you believe we have used your intellectual property without permission. Feel free to scour our website to see if there is something in there that you claim is yours, and we will be happy to remove it.

They usually take a very dim view of people making any kind of profit off of their copyrighted materials. I suggest you review copyright law to insure you make accurate claims in the future. Meanwhile, perhaps I should contact the radio station myself to exchange this information.
